

UP State Legal Services Authority, Lucknow is going to conduct the Summer Internship Programme for Law Students. Applications are invited from the Law Students pursuing LLB from a recognized Law College or University for Internship Programme commencing from 14th June, 2017 for 10 working days.

Interested Interns may submit their applications upto 6th June, 2017 though email, fax, post and by hand in the office of UPSLSA.

The criteria for submitting the applications by the Interns is as follows:-

- 1- The students applying for the programme should be pursuing 5/3 yrs LLB course (3rd semester onwards) from any recognized Law University / Law College.
- 2- The application shall accompany nomination/ recommendations of the Head of the Department.
- 3- The applicant shall be required to be present on all the days of programme as per the schedule, prepared by UPSLSA. Absence on any day shall disqualify her/him from further participation. Also that no certificate of participation shall be issued to any such defaulters/absentees.
- 4- As female students shall also be participating in the programme, the male students are expected to give due respect to such female students. Any misdemeanor shall result in immediate termination of further participation in the training programme and the act(s) of misdemeanor shall be reported to the H.O.D. of his / her College/University.
- 5- The training programme is non- residential. The applicants have to make their own arrangements of boarding/lodging and transportation.
- 6- The interns shall be in formal uniform:
Boys: White trouser and white shirt and black coat with black tie and black shoes.
Girls: May put up white salwar suit and black blazer.
- 7- The students shall be required to submit a project report on the topic, which will be allocated by UPSLSA on the opening day of the programme. The short listed students may be provided with the specific topics in advance, on which they may be required to submit a write-up of up to 2000 words. Keeping in mind, the 07 schemes launched by NALSA and 05 focused areas adopted by the UPSLSA.

- 8- The Training Programme is designed in a way that it may provide practical exposure to the students to the working of the Judicial and Police Department with special emphasis on Criminal Justice Administration. Further the students may also be exposed to the realities of working of different institutions for protecting vulnerable women and children from unscrupulous elements and for providing care and protection to them. Therefore, it is proposed that the participating Law Students may be taken for visit to places like the Hon'ble High Court, District Court, Mediation Centres, Police Station, Children Home, Observation Home, Nari Niketan, Jails etc.
- 9- During visit to such places great caution and absolute discipline and etiquette is expected of the interns.
- 10- The students are expected to devote some time for social causes of great importance like legal literacy/awareness programme after having successfully completed the training programme.
- 11- No fee would be charged by the UPSLSA for the above training programme.
